

Notice to Bidders

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Avon-by-the-Sea, Monmouth County, New Jersey for SYLVAN LAKE LIVING SHORELINE PROJECT and be opened and read in public at the Municipal Conference Room at Borough Hall, 301 Main Street, Borough of Avon-by-the-Sea, New Jersey, on December 4, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. prevailing time.

The Work of this Contract includes Improvements to the Sylvan Lake shoreline, including stormwater outfall retrofits, site grading and landscaping.

Contract Documents for the proposed work, which have been prepared by Andrew Raichle, P.E. of the firm of Matrix New World Engineering, Inc. are available at the office of the Borough, and may be inspected by prospective bidders during business hours.

Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Contract Documents by request upon proper notice and payment of a non-refundable charge of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) payable to the Borough of Avon-by-the-Sea to defray the cost thereof. Proposals must be made on the standard Proposal forms in the manner designated in the Contract documents; must be enclosed in sealed envelopes bearing the name and address of the Bidder and the name of the project on the outside and be addressed to Mayor and Borough Council, Borough of Avon-by-the-Sea, and must be accompanied by a Statement of Consent of Surety from a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and acceptable to the Borough of Avon-by-the-Sea. The successful bidder is hereby notified that a performance bond for the full amount of this project is required. By virtue of Executive Order #34 (1976), vendors currently suspended, debarred or disqualified are excluded from participating on this project.

The Borough or the Engineer reserves the right to require a complete financial and experience statement from prospective bidders showing that they have satisfactorily completed work of the nature required before furnishing proposal forms or specifications, or before awarding the Contract. Proposals for this Contract will only be accepted from bidders who have properly qualified in accordance with the requirements of the Contract documents. The right is also reserved to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities where such informality is not detrimental to the best interest of the Borough. The right is also reserved to increase or decrease the quantities specified in the manner designated in the Specifications.

The successful bidder shall be required to comply with the following:

- A. Affirmative Action requirements (P.L. 1975, C.127, N.J.S.A. 10:5-1 et seq.).
- B. The provisions of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq.).
- C. Anti-Kickback Regulations under Section 2 of the Act of June 13, 1934, known as the Copeland Act.
- D. Worker and Community Right-to-Know Act (N.J.A.A. 34:5A-1).
- E. Contractor requirements for projects funded by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Moreover, the bid must be accompanied by a list of names and addresses of all stockholders owning 10% or more of the stock in accordance with the provisions of the Public Disclosure Law (P.L. 1988, C.33, N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2).
