RESOLUTION No. 65 offered by _____, seconded by _____ permitting temporary outdoor dining for existing restaurants within the Borough of Avon by the Sea.

WHEREAS, as a result of the COVID-19 Emergency, declared by the Governor beginning March 8, 2020, many local businesses have been forced to close in order to comply with the Governor’s various Executive Orders establishing numerous safety standards and regulations intended to provide for greater public safety; and

WHEREAS, since that time local business, including restaurants, have diligently complied with the requirement to close their door and only offer takeout and delivery of food; and

WHEREAS, the result of these efforts have been a significant lowering of the rates of infection over recent weeks, so much so that most closed businesses have been allowed re-open; and

WHEREAS, June 1, 2020, the Governor announced that restaurants will be permitted to conduct outdoor dining commencing on June 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, allowing temporary outdoor dining, will provide an opportunity for our Borough restaurants to begin returning to their normal course of business, but in a safe and orderly way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Avon by the Sea in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that it hereby authorizes the temporary allowance of outdoor dining for restaurants within the Borough of Avon by the Sea with the standards outlined in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this allowance and these standards will expire seven (7) days after the end of the declared state of emergency by the Governor, or when the State permits restaurants to open for indoor dining, whichever shall occur first.
