We wanted to thank Borough residents for following the CDC, State, County and local COVID 19 directives. In order to further contain and control the virus, through May 15, 2020, we are going to need to keep in place the closures of the Municipal Building Gym, Library, Marina Building, playgrounds, tennis courts, basketball courts, ball field and Volunteer Park.

The Boardwalk will continue to be closed until further notice. The beach will still be open with access available at East End and Washington Avenues. With the reopening of the Ocean Avenue Bridge, closing of all State and County Parks, and the arrival of warmer weather, we are starting to see more people walking, jogging and cycling on the east side of Ocean Avenue where we have provided limited parking. In order to give people in this area sufficient space to be socially distant and to protect them from traffic on Ocean Avenue, we are going to eliminate all parking on Ocean Avenue, effective on Friday April 10 at 6AM. Joggers, walkers and cyclists will now be able to use the sidewalk and diagonal parking places that will be separated from vehicle traffic by cones.

The Borough offices will continue to be closed to the public, but the office staff is still working. Borough staff and officials will not be meeting in person with the public. If anyone has a bill, application or form to submit to the Borough, they can mail it to the office or place it in the drop box in front of the municipal building.

The Borough has suspended all inspections for seasonal rentals until May 15.

For trash collection, until further notice, residents should not leave out bulk items and residents should securely tie their trash bags for the protection of our workers. For recycling, while regular pick-ups will continue, we urge residents whenever possible to bring their recycling to the Recycling Center.

The next Board of Commissioners meeting will be on Monday April 27, 2020. The meeting will be telephonic. Prior to the meeting, we will post the Agenda and the call-in number for the public on the Borough website.

We thank everyone for their cooperation and assistance.
